



Early progress for PANOPTESSEC after the Plenary Design Meeting

The PANOPTESSEC project, aiming to deliver a beyond-state-of-the-art prototype that will proactively and reactively automatically manage cyber incidents, held a Plenary Design Meeting on 3-5 June at the ACEA facilities in Rome. ACEA, one of the largest Italian companies for energy and water supply, is the user agency of the PANOPTESSEC project.

The Plenary Design Meeting contributed to the progress of essential components of the operational concepts, design and interfaces. Early results of PANOPTESSEC progress were then demonstrated by Alcatel-Lucent at the NATO SAS-106 Symposium on “Analysis Support to Decision Making in Cyber Defence and Security” on 10 June. The PANOPTESSEC Technical Project Manager from RHEA was chairing the SAS-106 Symposium session and observed that the early prototype demonstration of technology was very well received by the attendees as a tangible outcome of the project.
